About the Institute



National Skill Training Institute (Women), Allahabad (Erstwhile Regional Vocational Training Institute, Allahabad) facilitates vocational training with an objective to train women from economically weaker sections of the society to equip them with the employability skills, coupled with access to employment and entrepreneurial opportunities with which they will be able to earn a better livelihood and respect in the society.

The institute offers various courses under Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) and Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS). To strengthen industry connect and impart industry relevant training all the courses under CTS scheme are in Dual System of Training (DST) mode. To help students match their skills with current industrial requirement, NSTI(W), Allahabad recently introduced two New Age courses such as IoT Technician (Smart City) & IoT Technician (Smart Agriculture) under CTS & a high end Advanced Diploma course in IT Networking & Cloud Computing.

NSTI(W), Allahabad has a rich tradition of pursuing excellent skill education along with value education and conducive environment for overall development of trainees. Through various co-curricular activities, we try to make our students more skillful, knowledgeable and confident so that they can face the challenges of today's world.

Courses Offered

Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS)

No. of Trades - 10
Duration - 1/2 Year

Introduced by the Government of India in year 1950 to ensure a steady flow of skilled workers in different trades for the domestic industry, to raise quantitatively and qualitatively the industrial production by systematic training, to reduce unemployment among the educated youth by providing them employable skills, to cultivate and nurture a technical and industrial attitude in the minds of younger generation.

Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS)

No. of Trades - 7
Duration - 1 Year

Training of Craft Instructors is the mandated responsibility of DGT and It has been operational since the inception of the Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS). Comprehensive training both in skills and training methodology is imparted to the instructor trainees to make them conversant with techniques of transferring hands-on skills, to train skilled manpower for the industry.

New Age courses (CTS)

No. of Trades - 2
Duration - 1 Year

New Age CTS Courses are designed to cater the demand of skilled manpower in newly emerging areas. These courses will be on the lines of CTS (Craftsman Training Scheme) pattern.

Advanced Diploma in IT Networking & cloud Computing

No. of Trades - 1
Duration - 1 Year

This Course will help the students the most to enhance the employability and create industry pathways for students by helping them to start their own enterprise in cloud maintenance or computer hardware maintenance. Alternatively, students can apply for jobs in Industry as system technician, cloud developer, web designer and trainers (future skills).

1. Craftsmen Training scheme (CTS)

The Scheme is the most important in the field of Vocational Training, has been shaping craftsmen to meet the existing as well as future manpower need, through the vast network of ITIs spread over various States / Union Territories in the country. The day-to-day administration of ITIs under the Craftsmen Training Scheme was transferred to the State Governments/ Union Territory administrations with effect from the year 1956. From 1st April 1969, the financial control of the Industrial Training Institutes in the States as well as in the Union Territories was transferred to the respective State Governments / Union Territory. The financial assistance was granted to them in the form of bulk grant in consultation with the erstwhile Planning Commission and the Ministry of Finance.

2. Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS)

Training of Craft Instructors is the mandated responsibility of DGT and It has been operational since the inception of the Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS). Comprehensive training both in skills and training methodology is imparted to the instructor trainees to make them conversant with techniques of transferring hands-on skills, to train skilled manpower for the industry.

During admissions in academic session 2021, it was assessed that about 15,000 ITIs with seating capacity of more than 35 lakhs and the skill ecosystem have more than 95,000 instructor positions. But, only about 15% of these are currently trained under CITS. NCVT has mandated that all trainers in ITIs need to be CITS trained. Present capacity in National Skill Training Institutes (NSTIs) for training of trainers is 8125 per annum with total seating capacity being 12765 (including of govt. and pvt. ITOTs – 4640). During academic year, August 2021, the total of 8133 candidates have taken admission (63% seats were filled) in NSTIs.

Under the Craft Instructor Training Scheme programme, the eligible candidates are those who possess NTC/ NAC/Diploma/Degree qualifications. Training in 27 Engineering trades and 9 non-engineering trades is being offered.

3. Diploma

This course is conducted by Directorate General of Training (DGT), MSDE and offered through the National Skill Training Institutes (NSTI) under National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT).

Nowadays, the dependency on cloud computing has increased manifold and already there is a shift towards cloud-based storage. To equip students with a hands-on experience in this latest technology, National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT), partnering with IBM, is offering admission to this Advanced Diploma Course in IT, Networking & Cloud computing. As an industry partner, IBM is providing help to design the course to suit the requirements of the industry. The total duration of this training is 800 hours spanning two years.
